Twin Turrets can be your dream home

CAPE MAY POINT - The term "dream house" can conjure up a number of images in the mind of a homebuyer.

The Twin Turrets house at 101 Whilldin in Cape May Point most likely conforms to a number of those images.

Located at the corner of Whilldin and Harvard, 101 Whilldin, the Whilldin Beach entrance is right across the street. You literally cannot get closer unless you were living on the beach.

Uniquely constructed so as to have three levels, the second floor is only a half level above the first, and so on.

Enter this house, with its upside down design, and you can walk straight into the utility room, also accessible from the carport. To the right is the master bedroom. The master bedroom is designed with a large sitting area, that includes a wet bar, and you will find the bed tucked into one of the turret areas. Just beyond that is the master bath with his and hers vanities and a spa tub. The lavatory is behind a separate door.

To the left of the entrance is a half flight of stairs leading to the second floor living area. This part of the house, built over the carport, has two bedrooms, a bathroom with tub and



sink, and the lavatory across the hall.

Another half flight of stairs takes you to the third level (or second level on the Harvard Street side) where there is a great room and kitchen. The great room, with its cathedral ceiling, includes dining and sitting areas and a fireplace. It also has sliding glass doors that lead out to a deck looking out at the Whilldin Beach.

The kitchen area has a skylight to add brightness to the tiled, efficient kitchen.

"The proximity to the beach is one of the best features," real estate agent Lee Marcotte said. "You can enter the beach at the end of Whilldin Avenue."

Marcotte said the wide open space of the living and master bedroom areas is another key feature of the house. Ample second and third bedrooms and closet and pantry space, plus a carport with room for two vehicles area also assets.

"The way the bedrooms are situated, on their own separate level, means kids can be sleeping in their beds and not be disturbed by adults in the great room having a party," Marcotte said. "It's a very unique design."

Marcotte said the builder obviously took into consideration the beach view, constructing the home with the living space on the upper level so the own
