"This place has an old look and feel, but it has every modern amenity that people are looking for in today's mar-

ket," he added. That includes energy efficiency, Bezaire said.

The exterior of the house is sided with fireproof hardy board, giving it the appearance of cedar shake shingles, but is maintenance free.

Renovations included taking the sec-ond floor master bedroom and moving it out over an existing porch area. The master suite features a walk-in, his and hers closet and dressing area. The result is a master suite with a vaulted ceiling and a view over the landscaped yard with saltwater pool featuring waterfalls, a coy pond, ornamental trees and brick walkways.

Bezaire said the salt water in the pool is better on the skin, and once the bal-ance is right, it doesn't need chemicals to maintain.

The expansive patio area leads into the large main kitchen.

"You could easily entertain 30 people in this area alone," Bezaire said of the outside space.

At the other end of the patio is the pool house, which is currently outfitted with a large screen TV and soft furniture, making it a relaxing getaway on game day. It could also be used as a guesthouse.

It is only from the patio area that one is aware of the solar panel array above the kitchen. Bezaire said the use of solar energy helps alleviate the cost of airconditioning a large house in the summer. The house was outfitted with a high velocity air-conditioning system, which is typical of renovated older homes.

The former master bedroom on the second floor was converted into an enormous bathroom with an antique tub and an extra large, glass encased show-





er stall. Original timbers in the ceiling were left exposed to lend to the historic character of the house.

The house has five bedrooms in all, but there is extra sleeping space and the potential for another bedroom. Besides the master suite on the second floor there is a guest suite with a full bathroom, opening out to a private balcony. This bathroom features a hand-tiled bathtub.

The third floor consists of three unique rooms, which although considered bedrooms, have the potential to be anything the new owners desire - children's playroom, arts and crafts rooms, etc.

Bezaire said the garage was converted so the front is storage space and the back is a mother-in-law apartment. Essentially a studio apartment, this space
