An impeccable home with a lot to offer

WEST CAPE MAY – There are some homes that just don't look that big from the outside, but on a walk-through, you are amazed at what is inside.

The house at 927 Farmdale Dr. is that kind of house.

Listed at a two-story, four bedroom house, one has to see the size of the rooms to truly appreciate what the potential buyer is getting. Presently, the smallest bedroom in the house is being used as an office, but it could easily be converted to a child's bedroom or other sleeping space.

A bonus room over the attached twocar garage has the potential to be a fifth bedroom, but at about 30 feet long, it could be a room for crafts, art, entertainment, exercise or anything the new

owner desires. Immaculately maintained, this house is just under 3,000 square feet. Built in 2001, the home appears to be much newer, and sits in a cul de sac where every home is well-maintained with manicured lawns and landscaping. This home has city water and sewer, but also has a deep well for irrigation.

The development also features sidewalks, something not seen in other parts of town.

"The neighborhood is well-main-tained," said Jim Zeitler from Jersey Cape Realty. "Over 50 percent of the homeowners are year-round residents."

The first floor features a master suite separated by French doors. The master suite features two walk-in closets (his and hers), and an enormous bathroom with a jetted tub.

As one walks in the house there is a large, bright great room that sets the tone for the house. The entire house at 927 Farmdale Dr. is bright with nature light from its many windows. And each room has its own ceiling fan to go with the multi-zone central air-conditioning. Continuing the theme of extra space, the upstairs bedrooms were designed with storage area in mind.

Besides the large bedroom connected to the master suite, there is a full bath-
