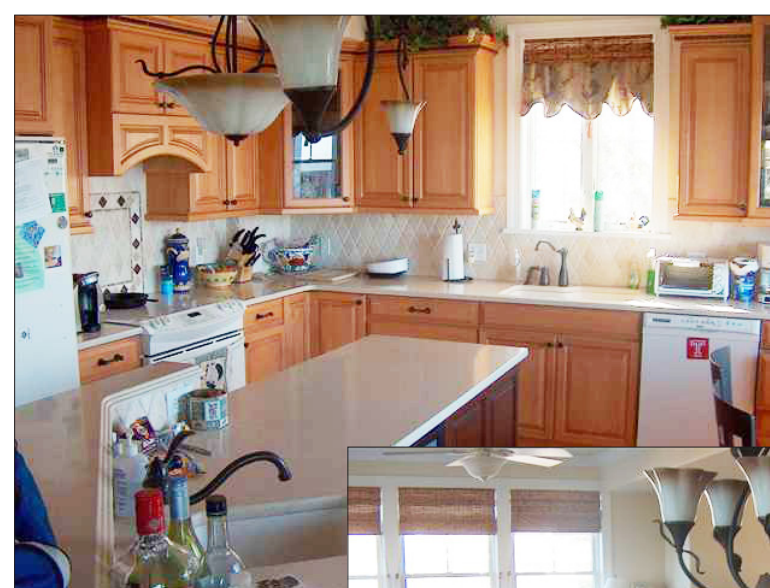
## Large bayfront home has many possibilities

LOWER TOWNSHIP – If someone is looking for plenty of room and an unfettered bayfront view, the home at

3301 Shore Drive offers a lot of possibility.

Located in the Cape May Beach section of Lower Township, this upside-down home has three floors with five bedrooms and four full baths.

“The house has three separate levels. Each floor has own sitting area,” said Jim McBride, a sales associate with Coldwell Bank Sol Needles Real Estate. “The first floor has three bedrooms, the second floor has an open living area with the kitchen and living room, and the third floor is

master bedroom with a private deck and living area.”

McBride said the house has an elevator that reaches all three levels.

In addition to the five bedrooms, there is more space in

this home which can be transformed into a home gym or office.

“The third floor could be a huge master suite living area with a master bedroom, office and exercise area. It has some nice bells and whistles,” McBride said.

This large beach home comes with a modern kitchen and comfortable dining areas. An added feature is a built-in brick fireplace.

McBride said the size and location of 3301 Shore Drive make it an exceptional property.

“There is a panoramic view that is really is gorgeous, and there is direct beach access. It’s a nice feet in the sand type situ-

ation,” he said.

The home is large enough that it is perfect for entertaining or sharing by anyone who has extended families.

“Because of its size, all the decks and screened in porches, there are a lot of spaces that are perfect for entertaining. There is room for the family, from grandpop to grandkids,” McBride said.

McBride said because of the living area on each floor there is enough space to congregate without being overcrowded.

“There’s a good flow,” he said. “And it’s right on the water.”

The home itself is on a 75’x125’ lot, nestled in the dunes of the Delaware Bay, where the owners will have a sunset view every night from any of multiple open decks, an enclosed patio or screened porch. An outside shower prevents guests from tracking sand onto the wood flooring.

The interior includes a living room, dining room, den, family room, eat-in kitchen, laundry room and a great room. The house includes an elevator and security system, as well as oven, refrigerator, washer, dryer and dishwasher.

The house may be heated with natural gas or propane, and has multi-zone central air-conditioning.
