

# What's open in Cape May area during state shutdown

With the mandated closing of New Jersey restaurants and bars for eat-in services March 16, area restaurants have taken steps to provide delivery options to residents.

5. Wed & Thurs Apr 8 & 9: North of Michigan, Indiana and Massachusetts Aves.

6. Mon & Tues April 13 & 14: North of Cape May Avenue
