

ELTC continues outdoor events with 'Tales,' workshop

CAPE MAY — In spite of not being able to perform as usual, East Lynne Theater Company's artistic director, Gayle Stahlhuth, figured out how two of its programs could continue — "Tales of the Victorians" and its annual Student Theater Workshop.

"Tales" aren't taking place as usual on the

porches of B&Bs, and the workshop, usually nine days inside, will now be four days outside in July, but still with a performance.

Stahlhuth said she was thinking of canceling the workshop but that parents of performers reached out to her, asking that the workshop continue in some fashion.

With the success of "Tales" being performed in a backyard, she said she decided to locate the workshop in a backyard, too.

The Student Summer Workshop is scheduled for 4 to 5 p.m. Monday, July 27, to Wednesday, July 29, with a performance at 4 p.m. Thursday, July 30, as part of the regularly

scheduled "Tales of the Victorians."

Meanwhile, the weekly installment of "Tales" will feature Susan Tischler reading selections from "Helpful Hints" at 4 p.m. Thursday, July 2.

As usual at ELTC, children 12 and younger are admitted free.

Tischler was also in ELTC's "Sherlock Holmes' Adventure of the Speckled Band" and "The People of Cape May v. Johan Van Buren." From 2017-19, she performed for SPQR Theatre, also in Cape May, in "Calliope Rose," "The Wreck of the Spanish Armada" and her own original works, "Meet the Locals" and "Tao of Tisch."

She was then selected to perform "Tao of Tisch" at The Women's Theatre Comedy Showcase in Parsippany. Other credits include portraying Minnie Pearl and co-producing "Barry's Cape May Opry"

and "Barry's Christmas Opry," proceeds of the latter go to the West Cape May Christmas Parade. She is the co-owner of Kaleidoscope and Just for Laughs on the Washington Street Mall in Cape May.
