STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township Council of the Township of Lower, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey on October 21, 2019 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS SAFETY AND IDENTIFICATION IMPROVEMENTS TO SCHELLENGER'S LANDING, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER, IN THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$1,000,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$950,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): Various safety and identification improvements to Schellenger's Landing, including installation of new curbing and sidewalks, acquisition and installation, as applicable, of pedestrian safety equipment including, but not limited to, lighting, traffic control signals and signage, and installation of pedestrian crosswalks, rumble strips and pavement markings.
