ORDINANCE NO. 554-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF THE BOROUGH CODE

REGARDING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DEMOLITION

WHEREAS, Section 10-7 of the Borough Code regulates demolition within the Borough of West Cape May; and  
WHEREAS, the Borough of West Cape May Commission has determined Section 10-7 should be amended to clarify the Borough Official responsible for receiving demolition permits; and  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of West Cape May as follows:  
Section 1. The averments of the preamble are incorporated herein.  
Section 2. Section 10-7 of the West Cape May Code shall be amended to include the following (bold and underline portions constituting additions and strikethrough portions as deletions):  
10-7 DEMOLITIONS.  
10-7.3 Prohibition.  
Beginning the Friday before Memorial Day and ending the day after Labor Day of each year, any and all building demolition activities within the Borough shall be prohibited and no permit for building demolition shall be issued during this period of time. In the event of an emergency, or a danger to person or property, as determined by the Code Enforcement Officer or Construction Official, a building demolition permit may be issued during the restricted time period.  
10-7.4 Regulations.  
Before any existing building or structure or part of a building or structure is demolished, an application must be filed with the Code Enforcement Officer and Construction Code Official by the owner or person authorized by the owner. In addition to the application, the following information shall be provided:  
a. The full name and residence of each owner of the building or structure to be demolished.  
b. The name and address of the person or persons who are required to do the demolition work.  
c. A full description of the building or structure to be demolished.  
d. A statement as to the time in which the proposed demolition will start.  
e. A statement as to the time in which the proposed demolition will be complete.  
f. A statement as to the extent of the demolition of the building or structure.  
g. Any additional information that is required by the Code Enforcement Officer or Construction Code Official.  
10-7.5 Historic Structures.  
~~Before any existing building, structure or part of a building or structure is demolished, it must be determined whether that building or structure is located within a Borough of West Cape May Historic District. No permit for building demolition shall be issued until it is determined whether that building or structure is located within the Borough of West Cape May Historic District. If the building or structure is located within a Historic District, all demolition restrictions as set forth by the Borough of West Cape May Historic Preservation Commission shall be complied with prior to demolition approval. In the event of an emergency, or a danger to person or property, as determined by the Code Enforcement Officer or Construction Official, a building demolition permit may be issued during the restricted time period.~~  
10-7.6 Permit Required.  
It shall be unlawful to demolish any building or structure or part of a building or structure unless and until an application has been filed and approved by the Code Enforcement Officer and Construction Code Official. Once an application is approved, the Construction Code Official will issue a written permit. It is in the discretion of the Code Enforcement Officer and Construction Code Official to approve or reject any application filed that is incomplete.  
Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.  
Section 4. Severability. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.  
Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after passage and publication, according to law.
