The Cape May Star and Wave has been watching over the shores at the southernmost tip of New Jersey since 1854.

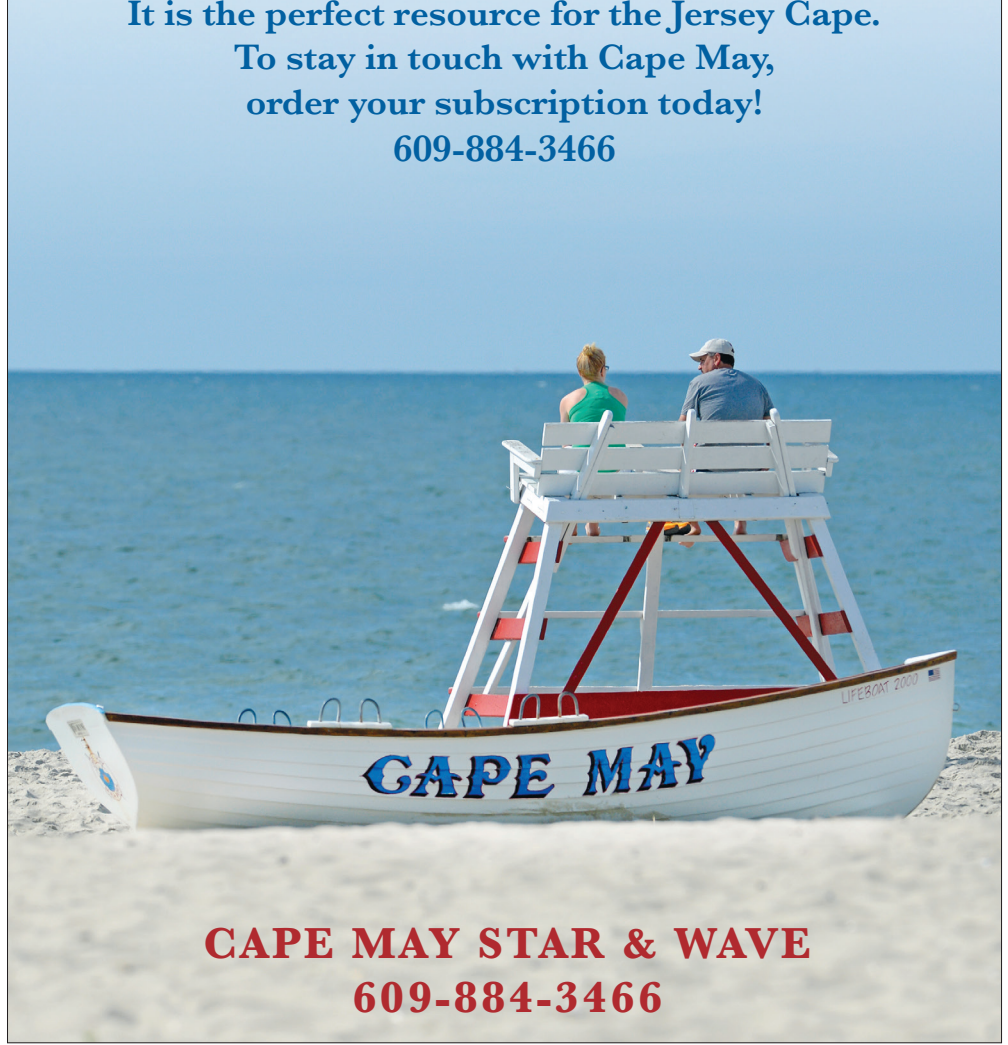

It is where locals and visitors have turned for their news weekly for more than 150 years.
