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the house, although for a moment you might believe there's just a mirror at one side of the room, with the beds made with identical covers.

In the third bedroom, one door leads to a closet, the other to steps to the large attic. The current owners have left it open, but it could allow for additional storage, or even be finished for a hidden game room, studio or crafts space.

The house has a basement, where the HVAC and water heater are stored, each on an elevated platform. The HVAC system is two years old and the water heater is five years old. The basement entrance is from the outside.

Heating is natural gas, as is the stove. The house has city water and sewer.

The house is a classic Cape May design, without

the gingerbread closely associated with the bed and breakfast inns but with the clean, functional design of the Victorian period when it was built. The neighborhood is shaded by the tall trees lining the street and quiet enough to seem far from Cape May's busy downtown, but it is really just down the road. Much closer are the courts of the Cape May Tennis Club and the scenic pond in Kiwanis Park on Madison Avenue.

The house is about a mile from the beach, depending on the route, making it about five minutes by bike. It's about a minute longer to ride to the Washington Street Mall for shopping and some of the best restaurants in the region.
