Preservation Commission ordinance; and WHEREAS, the Borough Commission of West Cape May has determined it is in the best interests of the public health, safety and general welfare to amend the definitions section to include a provision to

permit decking to be considered minor if it will not substantially affect characteristics of the historic site or the historic district. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Commission of the Borough of West Cape May as follows:

Section 1. The Section 27-19.2 "Definitions" of the Borough of West Cape May Code shall be amended as follows (strikethroughs indicating deletions and bold and underlined portions indicating additions) Minor application shall mean any application for a certificate of appropriateness that:

Does not involve demolition, relocation or removal of a historic building, resource, or structure; Does not involve an addition to a property in a historic district or

o construction in a historic district;

Is a request for approval of fences, decking, signs, lighting,

doors, windows, roofs, paving, exterior sheathing or streetscape work that will comply with the adopted design guidelines for the improvement proposed where a specific guideline applies and that will not substantially affect the characteristics of the historic site or the historic Is a request for a field change for a Certificate of Appropriateness

Section 2.Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict. Section 3.Severability. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after passage and publication, according to law.
