Spacious living at 703 Shore Drive

TOWN BANK – "Spacious" is a key word one might use to describe 703 Shore Drive in Town Bank.

cious floor plans and large windows provide great views and plenty of natural lighting.

Located just north of Town Bank Road on Shore Drive, real estate broker Todd deSatnick agrees it's a word that applies to this property.

plies to this property. "Spacious for sure," he said. "It also has abundant outdoor living areas, including a porch and two decks."

What is also somewhat unique about 703 Shore Drive is that the word spacious works top to bottom.

"This is a relatively high area of a neighborhood, so has full basement feature," deSatnick said. "There is a garage that has attic storage."

This two-story home also features a fenced yard.

Level one has a master suite with a private bath. The second level has three bedrooms.

"Level one also has a home office/den that has potential to be a fifth bedroom," deSatnick said.

The second floor deck can be reached from either the second level of the home or an exterior spiral staircase.

deSatnick said 703 Shore Drive is located in a great neighborhood for the outdoor enthusiast. Located in a residential neighborhood, it's just a short stroll to the Hobie Cat beach. The 1.5 car garage allows extra storage space for beach gear, bikes and kayaks.

"It's a great home base for the outdoor lover who wants to be within a few steps of the beach and everything it has to offer. It has west coast style sunsets and panoramic bay views and an unobstructed view from the second level. You get the bay front for the price and you get an unobstructed view," he said.

"This could be a year round home or vacation getaway – or an investment property with rental potential," deSatnick said.
